Bloor Homes is bringing forward proposals for new homes on land off Heath Lane in Lowton. The scheme would deliver up to 140 high quality homes, in a range of housing styles and sizes to meet local needs.

As part of a commitment to meaningful community engagement, Bloor Homes is undertaking public consultation on its draft plans.

Your views are very important to us as we want to ensure that our proposals are delivered in the right way and that they also bring significant benefits to Lowton.

Why is the site suitable for development?

Wigan Council has already identified Lowton as a sustainable settlement and the location of this site as particularly suitable to help contribute to the future housing needs of the borough. The site is ideally located, with good access to public transport, local jobs, schools and day to day shopping facilities.

What is Bloor Homes proposing?

- To build up to 140 new family homes;
- To deliver access from Heath Lane with pedestrian linkages through the land to the north to Stone Cross Lane;
- To provide 25% of the homes as affordable housing for local people;
- To enable linkages to the Public Rights of Way in the area;
- To provide on-site public open space and potentially children's recreational facilities.

We would welcome your feedback about any aspect of the proposals, including:

- Do you or anyone you know need an affordable home?
- Is there a particular type or size of property that is lacking in the Lowton area?
- What type of children's play area could the development provide?
